WHY WE CREATED THIS GUIDE

In September 2024, the Westend Seniors Activity Centre hosted our first Active Aging Series: Seniors Housing 101. The goal of this event was to bring in experts in seniors housing and **teach older adults** about the housing options available, what terms like "supportive living" and "assisted living" meant, what subsidized housing is, how to qualify, and more.



The event was sold out and it was a huge success. The speakers were fantastic but they provided a lot of information to the attendees. We realized that while the attendees learned alot that day, there was just too much information for them to remember it all.



OUR GOAL FOR THIS HANDBOOK

We wanted to design something that would give older adults a simple way to get information from the housing providers, go home and review the information to see which building they visited would be the best fit for them

We worked with housing providers like Chartwell, Optima Living, and Heartland Housing to develop the questions and then had our volunteers at our centre make sure the handbook was easy to use.

INDEPENDENT LIVING

Independent living is a housing option that allows seniors to live independently without the need for 24-hour care. This living arrangement offers the freedom to maintain their lifestyle, while also having access to amenities and support services as needed.

Amenities in an Independent Living community may include:

- Access To Nurse Or Health Care Aide (HCA) As Needed
- **Bed Linen Service**
- **Emergency Call Bells**
- Housekeeping Services
- Organized Activities & Entertainment
- Prepared Meals
- **Transportation Options**

SUPPORTIVE LIVING

To qualify for Funded Supportive Living, an Alberta Health Services Case Manager will assess your needs and authorize the care services. The care and services are funded by Alberta Health Services, with additional services potentially available for an extra fee.

Private Supportive Living would be paid by the resident, with no funding from the government and is not based on income.



ASSISTED LIVING

Assisted living is a housing option that provides personalized care and support for seniors who need assistance with everyday tasks. These communities offer a balance of independence and assistance, enabling residents to maintain their quality of life while receiving the support they need.

Amenities and services in an Assisted Living community may include:

- 24/7 Staffing To Provide Assistance With Daily Activities
- Bathing, Toileting, And Dressing Assistance
- Meals & Housekeeping Services
- Medication Management
- Organized Activities & Entertainment
- Wheelchair Transportation



WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU NEED TO MOVE TO ASSISTED LIVING

As you age, your personal care and support needs may change over time, requiring a higher level of assistance than what independent living can provide.

CAN THEY TRANSITIONING YOU TO ASSISTED LIVING?

You will want to determine if the seniors residences you are visiting, can transition from independent living to assisted living.

TYPE B CONTINUING CARE

This is private, personal living space and personal care for adults and seniors with a wide range of health issues. Services may include:

- 24/7 On-site Care Provided By A Health Care Aide and Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- Nutritious Meals And Snacks (Changes For Special Needs Can Be Arranged)
- Rehabilitation To Support Healthy Aging
- Social Work
- Weekly Room Cleaning

Registered Nurse care planning and health services are scheduled and provided by Home Care.

MEMORY CARE

CONTINUING CARE HOME TYPE B SECURE SPACE

Another funded option retirement residences offer is memory care for seniors living with dementia or cognitive impairment. Compassionate and friendly staff who are trained in dementia support help residents live each day in contentment and comfort.

A variety of services are offered to support residents living with dementia, including:

- Cueing And Assistance With Daily Routines,
- Bathing And Showering Assistance,
- Escort To Meals And Activities.
- and More.

To qualify, an Alberta Health Services Case Manager completes an assessment and then authorizes and schedules care at the retirement residence. Additional care and services (scheduled or unscheduled) may be available and provided at an additional fee.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT OPTION

It is important to carefully consider your current and future needs, financial situation, and personal preferences.

Assessing your level of independence, healthcare requirements, and desired lifestyle can help you make a decision that aligns with your long-term goals. When exploring different options it is important to make an informed decision, so be sure to ask as many questions as you can to assist in the decision making process.

One of the most important questions to ask is "what happens if I need more care down the road?" Our partners suggest that you sign up for Home Care with Alberta Health Services prior to moving in, so should additional care be needed in the future, it is ready to go.

Home Care can assist with things like medication management, bath assistance ane more while still allowing residents to live independently.
