WHAT IS ELDER ABUSE?

Elder abuse is not just physical; it is any action or inaction that jeopardizes the health or well-being of any older adult, including:

- › Physical abuse
- › Sexual abuse
- › Psychological abuse
- › Financial abuse
- › Medication abuse
- › Neglect

Often more than one type of abuse occurs at the same time.

WHAT TO EXPECT

When you call the Seniors Safe House Intake line, staff will help you determine if the Safe House is the best option for your situation or provide other information, supports, or referrals that can help. If you are not yet ready to leave the abusive situation, staff are available to continue to support you if you choose; and will help you prepare a safety plan. If there is space at the Safe House and you are ready, you may move in immediately. If space is not available, staff will arrange for safe housing at another location until there is space available.

If you, or a senior you know, is being abused, the Seniors Safe House can offer refuge and support.

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I have opened up to be a new person, like I used to be, thanks to your help and comfort. I've realized that there is help for seniors like me who have been abused, that **it is ok to get help.**
